Our mission is to provide police children with financial support and stability throughout their educational and developmental years following a significant change in family life.

Who we help

Our trustees will consider the children of:

- A serving officer who has died on/off duty
- A retired officer who has died
- A medically retired officer where the cause is on/off duty
- Special constables where there has been a death on duty

The officer must have been serving with one of our 22 contributing forces at the time of death or medical retirement and the children must be in some form of education.

An Officer's View

You never want to be in the worst situation but you may find yourself there.
